### PURPOSE OF TRAINING

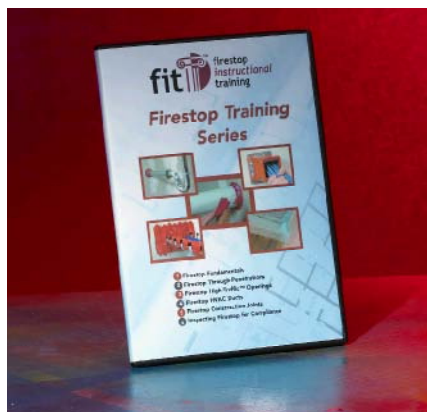
